

Bedazzle Beads

Long Knotted Necklace

Components:

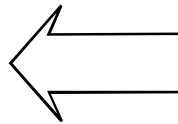
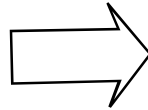
18 x Chunky Wooden Beads Of Your Choice
2 Metres of 1mm Cord (Your Colour Choice)
36 x 4mm Square Miyuki Beads



Tools Required:

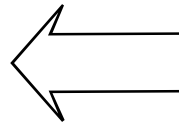
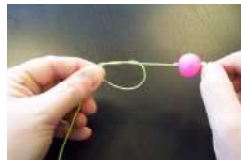
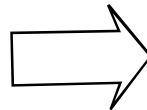
Cutters
Round Nose Pliers
Bead Board

Step 1: Lay your wooden beads at 1-1.5" intervals around your bead board



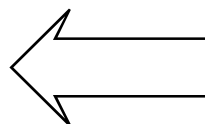
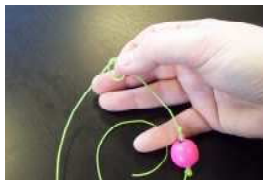
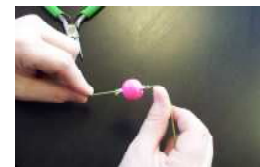
Step 2: About 5" in from the end of the cord, tie a double knot.

Step 3: Thread a size 4mm Square bead up to the knot, followed by a large wooden bead, followed by a 4mm square bead



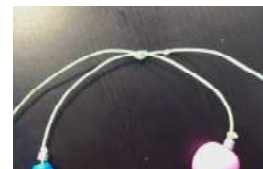
Step 4: After the second square bead, create a loop for the next knot

Step 5: Using the round nose pliers, slide the knot close up to the side of the 4mm square bead, before pulling tight close.



Step 6: Leave a 2" gap before creating your next knot and repeat from step 3

Step 7: Continue until all beads and cord have been used, leaving enough to tie a couple of overhand, double knots at the end of the necklace and trimming with cutters.



Try using with large acrylic beads, for different designs ...



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
